Orlando Rally to Feature Retired Lieutenant General

Orlando, FL- Vision America and First Baptist Church Central Florida will host a "God Save America Rally" Wednesday, October 31, 2012 at 7:00pm at First Baptist Church Central Florida at 700 Good Homes Road in Orlando, FL. Lieutenant General William G. "Jerry" Boykin along with Vision America's Rick Scarborough will be the evening's guest speakers. Admission is free.

LTG (Ret) William G. "Jerry" Boykin was one of the original members of the US Army's Delta Force. He was privileged to ultimately command these elite warriors in combat operations. Later, Jerry Boykin commanded all the Army's Green Berets as well as the Special Warfare Center and School. In his thirty-six years in the army, LTG Boykin also served a tour with the CIA. He has participated in clandestine operations around the world and served his last four years in the Army as the Deputy under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence. Today he is an ordained minister with a passion for spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ and encouraging Christians to become Warriors in God's Kingdom.

Rick Scarborough holds a Master of Divinity Degree from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and a Doctor of Ministry Degree from Louisiana Baptist Theological Seminary. He graduated from Houston Baptist University, with a double major in Political Science and Speech. In 1998 he founded Vision America and in 2008 he published the widely acclaimed book appropriately titled "Enough is Enough."
